### THE NEW CROSSWALK

As a result of the increased traffic flow and for the safety **of ALL** students and staff, St. Mary parents cannot use this space as a drop off and pick up location, **effective Monday December 3<sup>rd</sup>.** We are encouraging parents to use Margaret Street as a drop off spot and to utilize the crossing guards that are on duty.
