It has been brought to their attention that many parents are parking on the road and getting out of their car to walk their children to the school yard. These cars sitting on the side of the road are causing excessive congestion and could potentially cause accidents. The OPP have stated that they will begin to monitor this situation on Bridge Street and will be ticketing any vehicles they find. This will begin tomorrow or Monday. The OPP are also asking for the town to install new signs stating NO STOPPING.

We are asking all parents to please park in the parking lots to discharge or pick up your student. If you are unable to find a safe parking spot, there is plenty of parking
